Self-winding chronograph movement with calendar



Introduction

REBELLION Timepieces was born of the same passion for perfect mechanics as REBELLION Racing. Unique bodywork, exceptional technical materials, exclusive engines and outstanding performance: each collection pays tribute to the spirit of competition and car racing.

A strapping combination of angles, layers and curves, the Predator Chrono offers a perfect blend of watchmaking and automobile aesthetics. From its honeycomb dial to the bezel held by REB-PROPELLOR screws and buckle; every detail emphasizes high-performance racing mechanics. Boasting a generous 50-hour power reserve and date indicator, this solid chronograph also stands out for its original seconds' indicator at 9 o'clock. A short small hand runs from 0 to 30 while a larger hand

takes over from 31 to 60 seconds. Available with several personalization options, because there is no standard rebel.

The Case

With the complex construction of its case in superimposed layers, the Predator is highly customizable. You can choose the colors of the dial, bezel and glass and engrave the side plate at 9 o'clock. Available options: steel, steel and ceramic, red gold, red gold and ceramic, carbon bezel, carbon dial, colored dial and colored glass.

The Movement

This chronograph's robust and accurate Swiss Made movement guarantees precise timing of your performance, on and off the racing track. Ceramic, carbon



and steel combined in superposed layers give the watch its robust character and high performance capabilities. The substantial pieces are precision-machined: sandblasted black gold,

polished steel and a logo-engraved bridge. Mechanical perfection is revealed through the large sapphire crystal back. The Predator enjoys a generous power reserve of 50 hours.

Displays and Functions

BEWARE:

To prevent damage to your timepiece, please never adjust the date function between 8pm and 3am of your REBELLION watch. This is the only way to ensure that the date mechanisms are not engaged. Changing the date when the mechanisms are engaged could seriously damage the movement. We recommend adjusting the date in the morning, around 7am.



Settings:

Preparation for Setting the Time



This type of crown offers excellent protection against the penetration of water and moisture into the case. **Unscrew the crown counter clockwise (1) to POSITION 1 before engaging in any setting operations.**

Setting the Date



After unscrewing the crown (1), pull the crown out (2) to **POSITION 2** and turn the crown clockwise to set the date. After having set the date, simultaneously push and screw the crown back to the home position (details 3-7). **Please never adjust the date function of your REBELLION watch between 8pm and 3am as it could seriously damage the movement.**

Setting the Time



After unscrewing the crown (1), pull the crown out two clicks (4) to **POSITION 3**, adjust the hands to the correct time (NB: around midnight the date will change), simultaneously push and screw the crown back to home position (Details 5-7). When performing this operation make sure that the calendar changes the date at midnight and not at midday.



Winding



Your timepiece is wound automatically by your wrist movements. With those movements your watch sets the winding mechanisms and stores the energy. When it is fully wound and off your wrist, your timepiece has a power reserve of 48 hours. If your watch has not been worn for some time, you must wind it manually by rotating the crown. To wind your watch, unscrew the crown (1) to **POSITION 1**, turn the crown clockwise approximately 10 full turns (6), then simultaneously push and screw the crown (7) back to the home position.

Returning the Crown to Home Position



Simultaneously press and screw the crown (clockwise) back to the home position (7). We recommend regularly checking to ensure that the crown has been correctly and securely returned to the home position.

After each adjustment, screw the crown fully back home to the home position by pushing and simultaneously turning clockwise.

Chronographe functions



Start Mode: When timing a specific event, chronograph hands should be set to zero. To mark the starting point of the timer, press the **START/STOP** pusher. The hand marking the seconds should now be in motion.

Stop Mode: To stop timing, press again on the **START/STOP** pusher again. The pusher is now in **STOP MODE**.

Reset to zero: Activate the **RESET** pusher to set back to zero all the chronograph hands.

Recommendations: Care & Maintenance

For best care of your watch we advise:

- ✂ Clean your watch regularly with a gentle microfiber tissue to keep it in optimal condition.
- ✂ Avoid contact with water or sweat to prevent premature ageing of your leather strap.
- ✂ After immersion in chlorinated or salty water, rinse it in freshwater and leave it to dry completely.
- ✂ Avoid placing your timepiece anywhere where it might be subjected to major variations in temperature or humidity (e.g. sauna), or direct sunlight. Do not expose your watch to extreme temperatures (e.g. behind a car glass for long periods). Your watch's movement is designed to function ideally in temperatures ranging from 0°C to 50°C.
- ✂ Avoid placing your timepiece near strong magnetic fields (e.g. speakers, electrical motors, etc.) as they can affect the running of your timepiece.
- ✂ Avoid any contact with abrasives, hazardous gases, solvents, detergents, mosquito repellent, sun creams, perfumes, cosmetic products, or other chemical products as they may damage the watch case, the strap, the glass or synthetic parts of your watch.
- ✂ Avoid any type of shocks to your watch. In the event that your watch is exposed to any violent impact or shock, have your watch checked by REBELLION Timepieces immediately.

- ✂ Never use your watch's pushers, wind the watch or adjust time/date when the watch is wet or has had any contact with water. We recommend this to avoid water penetration, even if your timepiece is water resistant. This is to minimize risk of water entering the case and being exposed to moisture.
- ✂ Check if the crown is securely returned to the home position after each adjustment to prevent any water intrusion.
- ✂ We also recommend that you never adjust the date function between 8pm and 3am of a REBELLION timepiece as it could seriously damage the movement.

HAVING YOUR WATCH SERVICED

To ensure the running of your watch, we advise regular service and maintenance by our workshop at REBELLION Timepieces S.A. As with any racing car, the exclusive motor of your timepiece needs regular servicing in order to function to its fullest potential. We advise you to have your watch serviced at least once every 3 to 5 years by our workshop at REBELLION Timepieces S.A. We suggest you to take your watch to an Authorized REBELLION Timepieces Retailer who will send it to our workshop where it will be inspected and analyzed by our watchmakers. During your watch's maintenance, the case and the movement will be completely disassembled, cleaned lubricated and reassembled. Then rigorous accuracy calibrations and water resistance tests will be performed. Upon request, the case and the buckle will be refinished and polished. The full



process takes several weeks because each watch must pass several tests to ensure REBELLION Timepieces' quality spirit.

WATER RESISTANCE

Your Predator Chrono is 100 meters (10atm) water resistant. Water resistance cannot be guaranteed indefinitely. In case of intensive use underwater, annual pressure tests are recommended. Under normal conditions, we recommend testing every 2 years. The pressure test takes only a few minutes and can be performed at any official center for REBELLION Timepieces or by an Authorized Retailer.
